Important News & Notes:

Winter uniform reminder: Students are required to wear the complete winter uniform beginning on Wednesday, November 1st. Please refer to pp 44-45 for grade -specific details of uniform requirements. Halloween at Slade reminders: Halloween costumes may be worn by all students, including middle school students on Tuesday, 10/31 only. Below you will find costume rules and guidelines. If students are not in compliance with these rules, a parent/guardian will be contacted to bring a change of clothes to the school. Costume Guidelines:

- No short skirts or shorts. No halter tops; see-through blouses; bare midriff tops; tank tops; crop tops, undergarments, or swimsuits. No bare midriffs, no bare shoulders, or low necklines.
- Costumes may not have parts that interfere with learning. This means no costumes that restrict movement or vision, prevent sitting at desks, or prevent participation in physical activities. Costumes must not obstruct movement in the hallways.
- No prop weapons whatsoever (nunchucks/spikes/chains/swords/knives/guns/water guns, etc).
- Footwear must be safe and supportive. No cleats, spikes, rollerblades, heelys, etc.
- Masks are prohibited to be worn in school. They may be worn during the parade so students are permitted to bring masks with them but are not permitted to wear them inside the school building.
- Makeup and hair products are permitted but must be removed by the next school day. Meaning, if hair color is adjusted for a costume, it must return to natural hair color by the following school day.
- No silly string or toy-like accessories.
- Nothing that promotes the use of illegal substances or activities or are derogatory, disrespectful or depict violence. Costumes cannot reflect any blood/gore.
- Costumes must not contain affiliation, promotion, or critique of any political party or candidate(s).
- Hats & hoods may be worn as part of costume but must be removed in the class-room or during any prayer.
- ALL costume preparations are to be completed at home. (No dressing or applying of accessories at school)
- No bikes, skateboards, hoverboards, or any disruptive props of any kind.
- Students may not wear costumes that make fun of others or make others feel uncomfortable.

The Halloween Costume Parade will begin at 1:15 p.m. in the parking lot. The parking lot will be set up with cones to map out where students will be parading. All families are welcome to attend and stand behind the set up cones. Please park along the back fence line.

Dear Parents and Students,

We are excited to tell you about a special tradition we have here at Monsignor Slade Catholic School during Christmastime. Once again, we will participate in sending toys to Apopka, Florida, for "The Christmas Store." This service project has been supported enthusiastically by students, parents and teachers alike for close to 40 years! This year, our Apopka Service Project will begin on Wednesday, November 1st, and conclude on Monday, December 4th.

Apopka is a migrant farm-worker community located just outside Disney World in Orlando, Florida. The farm-workers of Apopka work hard picking crops but are only paid a minimum wage, and struggle to raise their families and provide for daily needs. In an effort to help the workers, the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur developed, "The Christmas Store," a place where donated, new toys are sold for a nominal price. Since the farm-workers are very proud and prefer to buy toys for their children rather than receive charity, they can freely select a gift for their child like we do, and can leave the shop with dignity. All proceeds are turned back to the community to fund educational programs, such as literacy and pesticide training.

If you would like to participate, purchase one or more new toys with your child, such as good arts & crafts kits, "pretend" jewelry and make-up kits, educational games and books, bicycles, skateboards, scooters, tricycles, helmets, dolls of all colors, cars and trucks (especially medium/large vehicles), board games, and sports balls of all kinds. They can also use diapers, toys, clothing and blankets for infants and toddlers as well as new socks, pajamas and underwear for boys and girls. Allowing your child to help select the toy, and if possible, pay for part of it, will make the project more meaningful to your child.

We are very fortunate to have a great relationship with Southwest Airlines, who has generously agreed each year to provide air transport to Florida. Our student council members will pack up the toys on Tuesday, December 5th, and Southwest will come to pick up and then transport the toys to Apopka, Florida, on Wednesday, December 6th.

Our efforts in Apopka are greatly appreciated and are truly making a difference in the community. Thank you for your help and support!

Referral Program

Monsignor Slade Catholic School sponsors a family referral program, "Spirit of Slade," which rewards the families of currently enrolled full-day Pre-K—7th grade families who refer new families to Monsignor Slade Catholic School.



- Open to all MSCS families with students currently enrolled in full day Pre-K2 through 7th grade
- For every new family that lists your family's name in the "Referred by" field on their enrollment application and completes one full year of school at MSCS, your family will receive a **\$500** tuition credit for the following school year.
- Tuition credits are awarded on a per *FAMILY*, not per student, basis.
- You may refer more than one new family and receive additional credit. The amount of referral tuition credits cannot exceed the total tuition rate for one student in a family in any given year. Credits will not be applied until a family's FACTS account is activated for the year in which the credits are to be received. Tuition credits cannot be redeemed for cash.



To help as you refer new families:

- A new family is defined as a family NOT currently enrolled in the Edu-Care program/Pre-K2-8th grades at MSCS.
- Prospective families must list the full name of a referring parent or student on their initial enrollment application. Only one family may be listed as a referring family. There are no exceptions.
